<p>Equator - a line on a map or globe that divides the earth into north and south</p>	<p>Greenwich Meridian - a line on a map or globe that goes from the North Pole to the South Pole and that passes through the town of Greenwich in England</p>	<p>Latitude - the position of a place between the equator on the North Pole or the South Pole</p>
<p>Longitude - the position of a place east or west from the Greenwich Meridian</p>	<p>Hemisphere - half of a sphere or round shape, such as planet Earth</p>	<p>Co-ordinates - the reference points that give the latitude and longitude of a place on a map</p>
<p>Physical map - shows natural features such as rivers and mountains</p>	<p>Political map - shows places that humans have made, such as country borders and towns</p>	<p>Global - around the world</p>
<p>Scale - the distances on the map compared to the distances on the ground</p>	<p>Degree - a unit of measurement used to measure angles</p>	<p>Atlas - a book of maps</p>
