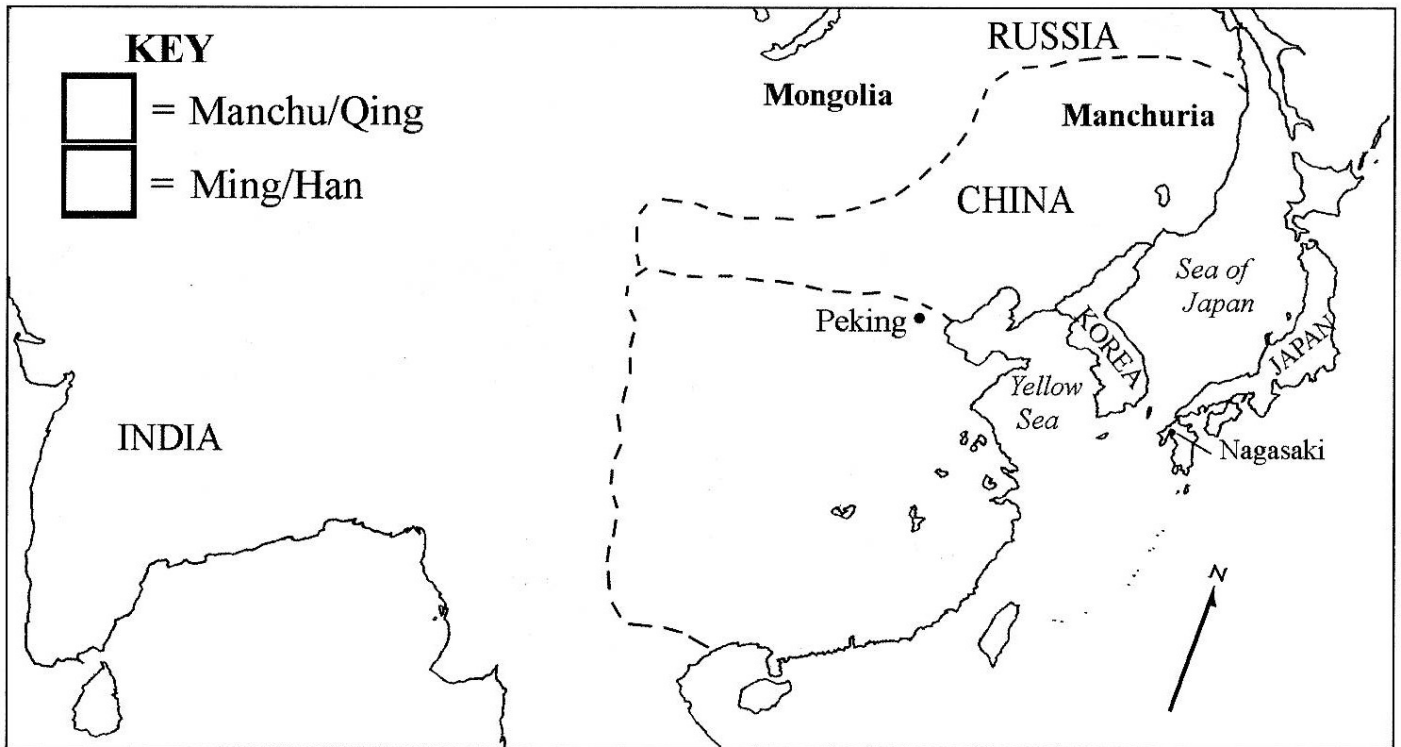


Far East of Europe
