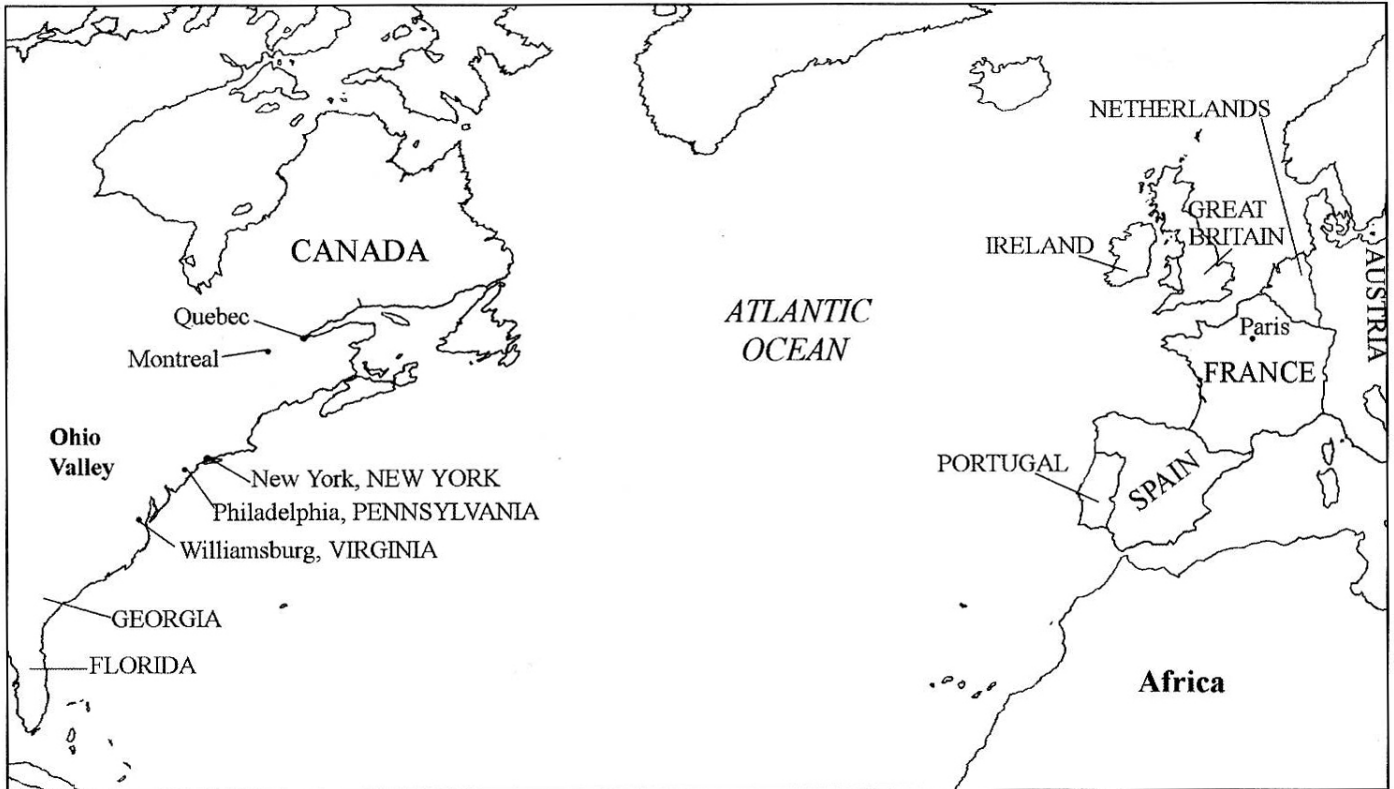


The English in India



- England, France, and Spain fought three wars that began in Europe and then spread to the colonies. In Europe, the English fought the French.
- The War of the Grand Alliance also included fighting in North America, where it was called King William's War. The English paid the Iroquois to attack French settlements in North America.
- The War of Spanish Succession began when Great Britain and the Netherlands declared war on France and Spain.
- Over in North America, the War of Spanish Succession was called Queen Anne's war. The English captured a French settlement east of Quebec, and the English marched down into Florida and burned a Spanish colony.
- The War of Jenkins' Ear began between England and Spain. But soon France joined Spain, and Austria joined England.
- Again, the fighting trickled over to the colonies.

NEW WORDS!

Protectorate - A state or territory partly controlled by (but not a possession of) a stronger state but autonomous in internal affairs; protectorates are established by treaty.

Succession - A following of one thing after another in time.
