

Revolution



- Great Britain wanted to pay for the Seven Years' War, so they taxed the colonies. The colonists were unhappy with the taxes, so the British sent more soldiers to the colonies.
- The taxes generated much income for Great Britain.
- In protest to the taxes, sixty colonists in Boston dumped 342 chests of tea into the Boston Harbour.
- Great Britain sent 30000 more soldiers to New York.
- The colonists, with the help of the French, surrounded the British troops at Yorktown.

Parliament was furious about the "Boston Tea Party". It passed a series of laws which the colonies called the "Intolerable Acts".


