- Napoleon directly ruled France and part of Italy.
- Members of Napoleon's family ruled Spain and the rest of Italy.
- Napoleon ruled the dependent states just to the east of France.
- The Louisiana Territory in North America belonged to France.
- Napoleon sold the Louisiana Territory to the United States so that he woud have money to expand his empire.
- Napoleon tried to invade Britain, but he failed.

Three years after becoming Consul, Napoleon told his council to make him Consul for life.
