

A Different kind of Rebellion



- England was becoming more industrial. Three major industrial cities in England were Manchester, Leeds, and Birmingham.
- Boston and New York were the early industrial centers in the United States.
- Many Irish came to New York to find jobs.

During the Industrial Revolution in England, Andrew Ure described what once a small village: "There are hundreds of factories... At the side of each factory there is a great chimney which belches forth black smoke and indicates the presence of the powerful steam engines."


